ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London having consulted with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to introduce social distancing measures on near a section of the A5 Edgware Road because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the Coronavirus pandemic.
3. The effect of the Order will be to:
 - (1) Shorten the existing loading only bay outside Nos.86-102 Edgware Road by 12 metres at its southern end the adjacent double red lines (no stopping at any time) will be adjusted to reflect the change replacing it with double red lines (no stopping at any time);
 - (2) Shorten the existing loading only bay outside Nos.44-58 Edgware Road by 14 metres at its southern end the adjacent double red lines (no stopping at any time) will be adjusted to reflect the change replacing it with double red lines (no stopping at any time);
 - (3) Introduce a loading only bay outside Nos.127-175 Edgware Road no stopping between Monday to Saturday 7am-7pm except for vehicles to load or unload for a maximum of 20 minutes;
 - (4) Stop on the A5 Edgware Road outside Nos. 55-71 Edgware Road;
 - (5) Stop on the A5 Edgware Road outside Nos.19-35 Court Mansion Edgware Road;
 - (6) Remove the loading only bay outside No.127-175 Edgware Road replacing it with double red lines (no stopping at any time);
 - (7) Remove the borough pay and display only bay outside No.127-175 Edgware Road replacing it with double red lines (no stopping at any time);

The Order will be effective at certain times from 12.01 AM on the 12th June 2020 until 11.59 PM on the 11th December 2021 or when the social distancing measures are not required, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
