ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE CRANMER ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable gas main repairs and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth subject to the agreement of Transport for London intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Cranmer Road which lies between Brixton Road and the eastern wall of Cranmer House, No. 3 Cranmer Road.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles would be available for affected vehicles via Brixton Road, Vassall Road and Foxley Road and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order would come into force on 5th October 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 5 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 5th October 2020 and 29th November 2020, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
