ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – HEADLAM ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable development related works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Headlam Road which lies between Kings Avenue and its junction with Plummer Road (approximately 60 metres).

2. The above road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Kings Avenue, Atkins Road, Poynders Road and Plummers Road and vice versa; and (ii) Kings Avenue, Allingham Road, Fairbourne Road and Parkfield Road.

4. The Order will come into force on 7th September 2020 and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 7th September and 30th September 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 3 months
