

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS**  
**FOR STREET PARTIES AND OTHER SOCIAL EVENTS IN**  
**CONNECTION WITH CAR FREE DAY**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable street parties and other social events in connection with Car Free Day to take place, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth Borough have made Orders the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) in the following roads and lengths of roads on the dates indicated:-

- (a) (i) Hexham Road, the whole length;  
(ii) Towton Road, between Arduli Road and Lavengro Road,  
on Saturday 12th September 2020;
- (b) (i) Brailsford Road, between No. 1 Brailsford Road and Nos. 29/31 Brailsford Road;  
(ii) Dalkeith Road, the whole length;  
(iii) Durban Road, the whole length;  
(iv) Spenser Road, the whole length;  
(v) Thurlby Road, the north-east arm, between Nos. 9/11 Thurlby Road and Nos. 45/47 Thurlby Road;  
on Saturday 19th September 2020;
- (c) (i) Arodene Road, between Helix Gardens and Helix Road;  
(ii) Chancellor Grove, the whole length;  
(iii) Eastmearn Road, between Dalmore Road and No. 2 Eastmearn Road;  
(iv) Talma Road, between its junction with Jelf Road and Felix Place and Mervan Road;  
(v) Trelawn Road, the whole length,  
on Sunday 20th September 2020;

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the restrictions referred to in paragraph 1 above will be available via adjacent roads.

3. The restrictions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs on the dates specified above.
