ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – DEERHURST ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out works to repair a water main, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Deerhurst Road which lies between the northern kerb-line of Streatham Common North and a point 10 metres north of that kerb-line.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the road closure described above will be available via (a) Streatham Common North, Minehead Road and Hill House Road and vice versa and (b) Streatham Common North, Valley Road and Hill House Road and vice versa.

3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 14th December 2020 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect for about 3 days but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may also have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
