Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
The Lewisham (Brockley Rise, SE23)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water work on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) One way working northbound between A205 Stanstead Road and St. German's Road. (2) The alternative routes for southbound traffic affected by the prohibition is via Brockley Rise, Stondon Park, Honor Oak Park, Honor Oak Road and the A205 South Circular Road.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 19th February 2021 to remain in force for up to 3 months.
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
