ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – CARPENTER’S
PLACE AND ROMEYN ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out essential water main connection works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of -

- (a) Carpenter’s Place, which lies between the south-eastern wall of No. 5 Carpenter’s Place and a point 10 metres north-west of that wall, except for access to or egress from properties in Carpenter’s Place; and
- (b) Romeyn Road, which lies between the south-eastern kerb line of Rosedene Avenue and a point 10 metres south-east of that kerb line.

2. An alternative route does not apply in relation to the closure described in paragraph 1(a) above as Carpenter’s Place is a cul-de-sac. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure mentioned in paragraph 1(b) above would be available via Romeyn Road, Leigham Court Road and Rosedene Avenue and vice versa.

3. The road closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 5th April 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been complete whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that the works mentioned in paragraph 1(a) above would be carried out between the 5th and 9th April 2021 and the works mentioned in paragraph 1(b) above would be carried out between 12th and 17th April 2021.
