

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – RADBOURNE ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable gas main replacement works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Radbourne Road which lies between Wier Road and a point 35 metres south-east of Weir Road.

2. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Hydethorpe Road, Thornton Road, the roundabout situated at the junction of Thornton Road, Weir Road, Atkins Road and Clarence Avenue and Weir Road and vice versa.

4. The Order would come into force on 29th March 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 29th March 2021 for 4 weeks, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect at other times within the maximum duration of 6 months.
