### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ROXBURGH ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate the installation of traffic calming works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Roxburgh Road which lies between its southernmost junction with Cheviot Road and the southern kerb-line of Bewlys Road.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above road closure would be available via Cheviot Road, Roxburgh Road and vice versa. Vehicular access to and egress from properties in Roxburgh Road would be permitted when it is reasonably practicable without inference with the works.

3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 26th March 2021 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for 2-3 days but if the works cannot be carried out or complete during that time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time or times within the maximum duration of 1 month.
