ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE HARPENDEN ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Harpenden Road which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Norwood Road and a point 10 metres south-west of Norwood Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Harpenden Road, Ulverstone Road, Ullswater Road, Norwood Road and vice versa.

3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order will come into force on 19th May 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect at night on 19th May 2021 between 11pm and 4am and at night on 15th February 2022 between 11pm and 4am, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
