

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY AT ANY TIME WAITING RESTRICTIONS**  
**- KENNINGTON ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable sewer repair works to be carried out in Kennington Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from parking, stopping and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in that length of Kennington Road which lies:-

- (a) on the north-east side, between its junction with Westminster Bridge Road and Mead Row;
- (b) on the south-west side, between the party wall of Nos. 2 and 4 Kennington Road and Cosser Street (including the parking places).

2. Whenever the ban referred to above applies:-

- (a) the north-west bound bus lane and bus route only in Kennington Road which lies between Lambeth Road and a point 14 metres south of Hercules Road; and
- (b) the south-east bound bus lane and segregated cycle lane which lies between a point opposite the party wall of No. 16 and Nos. 18 to 26 Kennington Road and Mead Row,

would be suspended.

3. The bans and suspensions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order would come into force on 24th May 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 24th May 2021 to 12th June 2021 but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time, the order would also have effect on subsequent days and dates within the maximum duration of 2 months.
