CONTINUATION OF A CAR CLUB PARKING PLACE IN PULROSS ROAD AND THE REMOVAL OF AN EXISTING PARKING PLACE

(NOTE: This notice is about the continuation of providing a car club parking place in Pulross Road that will be available for use only by the electric car club vehicle provided by Lambeth Council for businesses and market trader's in Brixton by way of the removal of the existing parking place to continue the accommodation of the car club parking place.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 26th May 2021 made the Lambeth (Car Club) (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2021 and the Lambeth (Brixton "B") (Parking Places) (No. 2) Order 2021 under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Orders will come into force on 31st May 2021.

2. The general effect of the Orders will continue the removal of the existing shared-use residents/business/pay by phone parking place on the north side of Pulross Road, outside the rear of No. 47 Bellefields Road that replaces it with car club parking place that will operate at any time and be for the use of a specific electric car club vehicle only. The electric car club vehicle that will be able to use the parking place will be one being used by certain businesses and market trader's in Brixton.

3. The Orders are intended to reduce the number of business journeys by diesel and petrol vehicles and reduce associated vehicle emissions and contribute to local air quality improvements, by providing a parking place for an electric car club vehicle that can be used instead of vehicles fuelled by diesel or petrol.

6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
