ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE RENFREW ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving a crane operation to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban:

- (a) vehicles from entering that length of Renfrew Road which lies between the southeastern kerb-line of Kempford Road and the north-western kerb-line of Dugard Way; and
- (b) pedestrians from entering that length of the footway which lies between the southeastern kerb-line of Kempford Road and the south-eastern kerb-line of Dugard Way.

2. The road and footway closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Kennington Lane, Durham Street, Harleyford Road, Kennington Lane, Kennington Road and Wincott Street; (ii) Kennington Lane, Newington Butts, Elephant & Castle, St George's Road, Lambeth Road and Kennington Road; and (iii) Wincott Street, Kempford Road, Reedworth Street, Kennington Road and Kennington Lane.

4. The Order would come into force on 19th May 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 7 am and 7 pm from 19th to 20th May 2021, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 1 month.
