ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY BANNED RIGHT TURN ROBSON ROAD & NORWOOD ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair works to be carried out on Norwood Road outside No. 372, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban buses and vehicles greater than 3.5t from turning right from Robson Road into Norwood Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Robson Road, Norwood High Street, Ernest Avenue, Knight's Hill and Norwood Road.
3. The banned right turn would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 7 th June 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 7th June 2021 to 11th June 2021, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
