ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY AT ANY TIME PARKING AND WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS FOR TELECOMMUNICATION WORKS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication maintenance and repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from parking or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) at any time in:-

- (i) Danbrook Road, both sides between a point 10 metres north-east of the party wall of Nos. 21/23 and 25/27 Danbrook Road and a point 10 metres south-west of the party wall of Nos. 25/27 and 29/31 Danbrook Road;
- (ii) Larbert Road, both sides between a point 10 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 42 and 44 Larbert Road and a point 10 metres north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 42 and 44 Larbert Road;
- (iii) Leonard Road, both sides between a point 10 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 36 and 38 Leonard Road and a point 10 metres north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 36 and 38 Leonard Road.

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 10th June 2021 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out on 10th and 11th June 2021 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates then the Order may have effect on subsequent days and dates up to the maximum period of 1 month.
