### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE WALCOT SQUARE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable new sewer connection works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Walcot Square which lies:

(a) between the eastern kerb-line of Kennington Road and the common boundary of Nos. 8 and 10 Walcot Square; and

(b) between the western kerb-line of Walcot Square (north to south arm) and the northwestern extremity of Walcot Square (north-west to south-east arm).

2. The road closures will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Walcot Square, Bishop's Terrace, Kennington Road and vice versa.

4. The Order will come into force on 24th May 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect from 24th May to 2nd June 2021, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
