Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Brightfield Road, SE12)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure to south-westerly bound traffic and no parking/ waiting in Brightfield Road, SE12 between Lee High Road and Hedgley Street. (Note: The works are located opposite No.2 Brightfield Road.)
(2) The alternative route for traffic affected by the prohibition is via Lee High Road, Lampmead Road and Brightfield Road.
2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, heavy goods vehicles delivering to Sainsbury's loading area accessed via Hedgley Street, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
3. The order comes into force on the 7th June 2021 to remain in force for up to 2 months.
4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
