ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A214 GLA ROAD (AMBLESIDE AVENUE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named, Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable SGN gas works to take place on the A214 Ambleside Avenue.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering or proceeding on Ambleside Avenue at its junctions between Mitcham Lane and Rydal Road. Local access to be maintained.

The Order will also permit all buses:

- (2) to turn right from Mitcham Road into Church Lane.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 29th May 2021 and 6th June 2021 every Saturday at 8:00 AM until Sunday at 4:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via: (For northbound traffic) A23 Streatham High Road, Streatham Hill, Streatham Place, Atkins Road, A205 Poynders Road, Cavendish Road, Cavendish Parade, A24 Balham Hill, Balham High Road and A214 Tooting Bec Road to normal route of travel. (For southbound traffic) Mitcham Lane, Streatham Road, London Road and Mitcham Road, Upper Tooting Road and Tooting Bec Road to normal route of travel.
