ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (WANDSWORTH) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A24 GLA SIDE ROAD (HEBDON ROAD) VARIATION ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that on 14th May 2021 it made the above named Order, under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 23rd May 2021.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order will be to:
 - 1) Remove the existing 11 metre Loading and Disabled Persons Vehicle bay on Hebdon Road on the side of No.178 Upper Tooting Road and replace with double red lines 'No Stopping at Anytime';
 - 2) Remove the existing 13.5 metre Parking bay on Hebdon Road opposite No.178 Upper Tooting Road and replace with double red lines 'No Stopping at Anytime';
 - 3) Replace single red lines at the entry of Hebdon Road/ Upper Tooting Road with double red lines 'No Stopping at Anytime'.
3. The roads which would be affected by the Order is the A24 GLA Road – Upper Tooting Road and GLA Side Road – Hebdon Road in the London Borough of Wandsworth.
4. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
