### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – GLENELDON MEWS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out water service connection works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Gleneldon Mews which lies between the northern kerb-line of Stanthorpe Road and No. 14 Gleneldon Mews.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above road closure will be available via **(i)** Gleneldon Mews, Gleneldon Road, Bournevale Road, Stanthorpe Road and Gleneldon Mews; **(ii)** Stanthorpe Road, Bournevale Road, Gleneldon Road, Shrubbery Road, Streatham High Road, Gleneldon Road and Gleneldon Mews.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 2nd August 2021 and it will continue in force for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
