### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE LYHAM ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable utility connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Lyham Road which lies between the southern kerb-line of Prague Place and the northern kerb-line of Crescent Lane.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Lyham Road, Kings Avenue, Thornbury Road and Lyham Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order will come into force on 12th July 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. Access for residents will be maintained throughout the works where possible.
