

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### Application for Grant of Premises Licence

George Arthur Brown has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises: Jus Jam Cafe, 60A Atlantic Road, London, SW9 8PY which would authorise the following licensable activities:

Sales of Alcohol between the hours of 12:00-00:00; Recorded Music between 07:00-00:00 and bank holidays until 02:00.

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to [licensing@lambeth.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@lambeth.gov.uk) and must be received no later than 20/09/2021.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
