# In-person tours at Graveney School

Graveney School is holding its Online Virtual Open Event for Year 7 pupils on Wednesday, October 13 from 9.30am and Thursday, October 14 until 8.30pm. The school will also be offering the opportunity for current Year 6 pupils to book in-person tours of the school for the week commencing Monday, October 11.

Graveney's sixth form virtual open event will take place on Tuesday, October 12 from 5pm. The sixth form will also be offering the opportunity for current Year 11 students from other schools, accompanied by their parent/legal guardian, to book an in-person tour for the week commencing October 18.

Further details regarding how to book these in-person tours for prospective Year 7 pupils and sixth form students will be available on our website in the admissions section from mid-September.

Graveney benefits from a beautiful, leafy campus, comprising 11 buildings including a former Georgian stately home, a Victorian school building, several architecturally interesting blocks built in the 1960s, a prize-winning new block which opened in 2016 and a second new block which was completed in September 2019, which includes 10 humanities classrooms and an observatory. This state-of-the-art Oppenheimer Observatory was awarded the New London Architectural Award in 2020.

Graveney has been deemed 'Outstanding' by Ofsted 5 times. In 2019 (the last time students were publicly examined), 91% of our pupils achieved a Grade 4 in English & Mathematics at GCSE. These results have been exceeded in the last two years and, with 50% of all grades at 7-9, Graveney is comfortably placed in the top 10% nationally for attainment. Perhaps more importantly though this success is shared right throughout the school community which means that all our students, from their



diverse starting points, are able to confidently progress onto their next phase of their learning.

Graveney's Year 7 pupils are drawn from a wide number of local schools, the vast majority of pupils living locally. In addition to a rigorous academic curriculum, a wide range of sports, musical and cultural extra-curricular activities are offered to ensure that pupils are well rounded and encouraged to excel in a variety of different walks of life. There is particular emphasis on outdoor education. The school is one of the largest Duke of Edinburgh centres in the country and partaking in these awards promotes confidence, resilience and a tight-knit community within the school.

Graveney sixth form students benefit from the collegiate feel of the campus which provides a well supported transition to

university and into the world of work. Students can choose from more than 30 A-level subjects and a small range of vocational courses, all taught on the Graveney site. The sixth form attracts a diverse range of students, from its own Year 11 as well as from other schools, who quickly settle into a cohesive academic community where aspiration is nurtured and opportunity is celebrated. Students mainly progress to higher education with very large numbers going on to Russell Group universities. The school is in the top 20 schools in inner London, and of these in the top 10 state schools, for Oxbridge entry; in 2021 nine students are taking up places at Oxford and Cambridge, including for medicine. Students make excellent progress and success is valued in all its forms. The sixth form provides a dynamic and positive experience, to enable

students to achieve their goals.

Graveney looks forward to welcoming you to the school's virtual open events. They provide excellent opportunities for prospective pupils and their parents to have a virtual tour of the school's facilities, to visit subject departments and see the exciting approaches to teaching as well as to find out the answers to the many frequently asked questions. 
Dancers from the school are part of many of the world's leading modern dance companies including Akram Khan, Pina

# A full, rich and balanced education

James Allen's Girls' School (JAGS) has been inspiring and educating pupils for more than 270 years, and educating girls is part of their DNA. JAGS is located in 22 acres of beautiful grounds in Dulwich, with great transport links from across London, as well as a coach service for pupils.

The energy, the vibrancy, the friendships and the support networks at JAGS all combine to build something very special.

The students at the school are very bright; they love learning and they are academically curious. However, a JAGS pupil prides themselves on much more than academics, using and developing their own creative, athletic and social skills to act upon concerns for others, while developing their own self-confidence and independence.

The pastoral care at JAGS is outstanding and pupils feel supported both by dedicated members of staff and by their peers.

At JAGS, what goes on outside the classroom is just as important as what happens inside the classroom. There is an absolute commitment to a full, rich and balanced education, and pupils throw themselves into their music, drama, sport and the hundreds of other opportunities that abound. This is a school where the pupils combine their scholarly talents with a dizzying array of commitments to activities, enrichment and the wider community.

It is where passionate individuals thrive in an atmosphere of compassionate challenge. The school is extremely diverse – and in the broadest sense of the word. Pupils come from different backgrounds and different cultures and enjoy developing a

wide range of skills. JAGS strives to attract intellectually curious girls, regardless of their economic background. Their bursaries are crucial in making them accessible to everyone, not just to those whose families can afford the fees. They have their own means-tested bursary scheme for all year groups from 11+ entry upwards.

#### What is a bursary?

Bursaries are offered to pupils who would benefit from a JAGS education but whose families are unable to afford the full fees. Bursaries are subject to financial circumstances and can offer financial assistance for up to 100 per cent of the fees, as well as the costs of uniform, travel, school trips and lunches. Currently, their bursaries cover well over 80 per cent of all fees for the 145 pupils whose families receive them.
