Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
The Lewisham (Cranfield Road, SE4)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Cranfield Road, SE4 between Harefield Mews and 49/51 Cranfield Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Brockley Road, Harefield Road and Wickham Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 25th October 2021 to remain in force for up to 3 months.

(Note: Works are expected to be completed by 29th October 2021)

- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
