ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ESTREHAM ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Estreham Road, which lies between its junction with Lewin Road and No. 41 Estreham Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Lewin Road, Streatham High Road, Natal Road; and (ii) Natal Road, Streatham High Road, Greyhound Lane.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 8th January 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 8th January 2022 and 27th March 2022, overnight between 9pm and 9am, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
