ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – RECTORY GROVE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water main connection works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban:-

- (a) all vehicles from entering that length of Rectory Grove which lies between Fitzwilliam Road and No. 60 Rectory Grove; and
- (b) vehicles and pedestrians from entering that length of the north-western footway of Rectory Grove which lies between No. 60 and No. 70 Rectory Grove (pedestrians would be directed to the footway on the south-west side of Rectory Grove).

2. The road and footway closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via: (i) Larkhall Rise, Clapham Manor Street, Clapham High Street, Clapham Common South Side, Long Road, Clapham Common North Side; and (ii) Fitzwilliam Road, North Street and Turret Grove.

4. The Order would come into force on 11th January 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 11th January 2022 for 4 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 6 months.
