### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE FAWNBRAKE AVENUE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Fawnbrake Avenue which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Brantwood Road and the south-western kerb-line of Poplar Walk.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Fawnbrake Avenue, Brantwood Road, Poplar Walk, Fawnbrake Avenue and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 21st January 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 21st January 2022 and 25th January 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
