ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE FAWNBRAKE AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Fawnbrake Avenue which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Brantwood Road and the south-western kerb-line of Poplar Walk.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Fawnbrake Avenue, Brantwood Road, Poplar Walk, Fawnbrake Avenue and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 21st January 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 21st January 2022 and 25th January 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
