

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE LEIGHAM AVENUE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out leak detection survey works safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Leigham Avenue, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 44 and 46 Leigham Avenue and Conifer Gardens.

2. An alternative route will be available for affected vehicles via Leigham Avenue, Woodleigh Gardens, Gracefield Gardens and Conifer Gardens.

3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. Whenever the ban on vehicles entering the length of Leigham Avenue described in paragraph 1 above applies the existing one-way traffic system in that length of Leigham Avenue which lies between Woodleigh Gardens and Conifer Gardens will be suspended to enable access and egress from properties and premises only accessible from Leigham Avenue.

5. The Order will come into force on 17th January 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried on 17th January 2022 and 17th November 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates then the Order may have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 12 months.
