ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE LEIGHAM VALE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Leigham Vale which lies between the western kerb-line of Norwood Road and the western boundary of No. 204 Norwood Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via:

(a) Leigham Vale, Palace Road, Probyn Road, Christchurch Road, Hardel Rise, Tulse Hill and Norwood Road; and

(b) Norwood Road, York Hill, Knollys Road and Leigham Vale.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 25th January 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect on 25th January 2022 overnight between 9pm and midnight and 9th February 2022 overnight between 9pm and midnight, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
