

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### Application for Grant of Premises Licence

Sam William Stobart has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises: Stobart's Stock, 29 Denchworth House, London, SW9 0BN which would authorise the following licensable activities: Off sales as 12:00-20:00 Friday-Sunday. The off-premise sales will include the sale of alcohol online, to be delivered. On premise sales 12:00-23:00 Friday and Saturday. This will be private supper clubs and events not exceeding 20 people.

The record of this application may be inspected during normal office hours by an appointment at the Licensing Section, London Borough of Lambeth, Third Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, Brixton, London, SW2 1EG, or via the licensing authority's website, at [www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing](http://www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing)

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to [licensing@lambeth.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@lambeth.gov.uk) and must be received no later than 11/02/2022.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
