Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Marischal Road, SE13)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of crane operations on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Marischal Road, SE13 between the projected northern kerblines of Lee High Road (at the western extents of Marischal Road) and the projected common boundary to Nos. 49 and 51 Marischal Road. (Note, in effect this is the one way section of Marischal Road) (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Lee High Road and Marischal Road, and vice versa.

2. The current one way working in Marischal Road is suspended during the works to allow access and egress.

3. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

4. The order comes into force on the 1st April 2022 to remain in force for up to 4 months.

(Note: There are several closures planned throughout the period that this order is in force. Notice will be given to residents and businesses affected. Most closures will be for a single day.)

5. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
