ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GARRADS ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable repair and maintenance works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Garrads Road, which lies between the southern kerb-line of Becmead Avenue and a point 40 metres south of that kerb-line.

2. An alternative route for affected vehicles will be available via Tooting Bec Road, Balham High Road and Bedford Hill and vice versa.

3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 19th April 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 19th April 2022 and 21st April 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
