ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS – HILL HOUSE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable service connection works to be carried out by UK Power Networks, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from waiting (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of Hill House Road which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of Maple Mews and the southern property boundary of No. 56 Hill House Road.

2. The ban on waiting and loading will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order will come into force on 25th April 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 25th April 2022 and 2nd May 2022. If the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time, then the Order may have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 2 months.
