

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – SLIP ROAD LINKING NORWOOD ROAD WITH DULWICH ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable traffic signal repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering the slip road that links Norwood Road with Dulwich Road, situated outside the entrance to Brockwell Park.
2. An alternative route would be available for affected vehicles via the main carriageways of Norwood Road and Dulwich Road. The ban on left turn from the main carriageway of Norwood Road into Dulwich Road would be suspended to allow for this route.
3. The road closure and suspension of the banned turn would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and/or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 16th May 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 8 p.m. and 3 a.m. on 16th May 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 1 month.
