ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – SELSDON ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable repair and maintenance works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Selsdon Road which lies between the party wall of Nos. 26 and 28 Selsdon Road and the party wall of Nos. 30 and 32 Selsdon Road.
2. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Wolfington Road, Hainthorpe Road and Dodbrooke Road and vice versa.
3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 16th May 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 16th May 2022 and 20th May 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
