ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STIRLING ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable repair and maintenance works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Stirling Road which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of Rhodesia Road and the party wall of property Nos. 10 and 12 Stirling Road.
2. An alternative route for affected vehicles will be available via Rhodesia Road, Clitheroe Road and Grantham Road and vice versa.
3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order will come into force on 25th April 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 25th April 2022 and 4th May 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
