

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application for a new Premises Licence

Notice is hereby given that London Chocolate has applied to the City of Westminster on 24th July for a new premises licence for 17 Connaught Street, London W2 2AY.

The proposed application is to permit for the sale by retail of alcohol. Monday 15:00 to 18:00, Tuesday to Thursday 12:00 to 20:00, Friday to Saturday 12:00 to 20:30, Sunday 13:00 to 16:00.

Any person who wishes to make a representation in relation to this application must give notice in writing of his/her representation by 21st August (28 days the day after the application is received by the licensing department) stating the grounds for making said representation to:

The public register where applications are available to be viewed by members of the public can be accessed online by visiting at www.westminster.gov.uk/Licensing and following the link to the public register.

The Licensing Authority must receive representations by the date given above. The Licensing Authority will have regard to any such representation in considering the application. It is an offence, under section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in or in connection with an application for premises licence and the maximum fine on being convicted of such an offence is £5000.
