ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – COLMER ROAD AND DANBROOK ROAD SPECIAL EVENT

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable a special event to take place, namely the Krishna Janmastmi celebrations, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to:-

(a) impose a one way traffic systems in –

(i) **Colmer Road**, between Ellison Road and Danbrook, in a direction towards Danbrook Road; and

(ii) **Danbrook Road**, its entire length, in a direction towards Ellison Road.

(b) ban parking and waiting by vehicles at any time in –

(i) **Colmer Road**,

(1) on the north-east side, (a) between the north-eastern kerb-line of Danbrook Road and a point 5 metres north-east of that kerb-line; and (b) between the south-western kerb-line of Danbrook Road and a point 5 south-west of that kerb-line;

(2) on the south-west side, between the north-western kerb-line of Ellison Road and the north-eastern wall of Shree Swaminarayan Temple;

(ii) **Danbrook Road**,

(1) on the south-east side, (a) between the northern kerb-line of Colmer Road and a point 5 metres north-west of that kerb-line; and (b) between the western kerb-line of Colmer Road and a point 5 metres north-west of that kerb-line;

(2) on the north-west side, from a point 5 metres south-east of the southern kerb-line of the south-east to north-west arm of Danbrook Road and a point 5 metres south-west of the kerb-line.

2. The alternative routes for vehicles affected by the one-way traffic systems will be available (a) northbound via Ellison Road and Colmer Road; and (b) southbound via Danbrook and Ellison Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 19th August 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 1 day. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will have effect between 5pm and 8pm.
