

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS –**  
**ESTREHAM ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable maintenance works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Estreham Road which lies between Hambro Road and Eucalyptus Mews.

2. The alternative routes for vehicles would be via (a) Natal Road, Streatham High Road, Greyhound Lane, Pathfield Road, Rotherhill Avenue, Greyhound Lane, Streatham High Road and Lewin Road; and (b) Lewin Road, Streatham High Road and Natal Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 22nd August 2022 for a maximum duration of 3 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed within 1 day, between 9.30am and 3.30pm, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 3 months.
