ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ALBERT EMBANKMENT AND SALAMANCA STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable development related works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:

- (a) entering that section of Albert Embankment which lies between the southern kerblines of Salamanca Street and the northern kerb-line of the access road leading to No. 20 Albert Embankment; and
- (b) travelling eastbound in that section of Salamanca Street, which lies between the eastern kerb-line of Albert Embankment and the western kerb-line of the access road leading to No. 18 Albert Embankment.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Tinworth Street, Vauxhall Walk, Black Prince Road, Salamanca Street and Albert Embankment.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 21st November 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take three weeks to complete, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
