ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – WELLFIELD ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable new electrical connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Wellfield Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 10 and 12 Wellfield Road and the common boundary of Nos. 14 and 16 Wellfield Road.

2. Alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles via Valley Road and Sunnyhill Road and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 10th April 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would have effect from 10th April for 12 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
