COFFEY STREET AND CROSSFIELD STREET

The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (No. 14) Traffic Order 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 6th March 2023 made the above-mentioned Order under the powers of sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Order will come into force on 13th March 2023.
2. The general effect of the Order will be, in connection with the Thames Tideway Deptford Church Street project post construction, to retain the following restrictions on a permanent basis:
 - (a) one-way eastbound working in Coffey Street, except pedal cycles; and
 - (b) one-way north-westbound working in Crossfield Street, between its junctions with Deptford Church Street and Coffey Street.
3. 4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act had not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
