Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Rangefield road, BR1)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic Order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the Order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Rangefield road, BR1 between Glenbow Road and the projected common boundary of Nos. 52/54 Rangefield Road. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Glenbow Road, Keedonwood Road and Rangefield Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the Order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3.** The Order comes into force on the 2nd May 2023 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are expected to be carried out in a single day on 2nd May 2023).
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
