

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – HANDFORTH ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water new water connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that section of Handforth Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 27 and 29 Handforth Road and the common boundary of Nos. 16 and 18 Handforth Road; and
- (b) ban pedestrians from entering that section of the northern footway of Handforth Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 20 and 22 Handforth Road and the common boundary of Nos. 22 and 24 Handforth Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Handforth Road, Brixton Road, Prima Road, Clapham Road, Crewsdon Road and Handforth Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 5th June 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 5th June 2023 and the 9th June 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
