

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING
RESTRICTIONS – SHRUBBERY ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate water main repairs, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Shrubbery Road which lies between the boundaries of Nos. 12 and 24 Shrubbery Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (a) Streatham High Road, Sunnyhill Road, Wellfield Road, Valley Road and Gleneldon Road and (b) Streatham High Road and Gleneldon Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 1st August 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 1st August 2023 and 18th August 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
