

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### Application for Grant of Premises Licence

Oktoberfest Events Ltd has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises:

The hardstanding 'Redgra' Site on Clapham Common (<https://what3words.com/pint.dimes.hits>) as well as the hardstanding 'car park site' to the South East of the main Redgra site. Clapham Common, London, SW4 9DE which would authorise the following licensable activities:

Live music, Recorded music and sale of alcohol, Thursday 5th October 17:00-22:30, Friday 6th October 17:00-22:30; Saturday 7th October 11:00-22:30, Sunday 8th October 11:00-17:00.

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to [licensing@lambeth.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@lambeth.gov.uk) and must be received no later than Wednesday 6th September 2023.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
