

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING
RESTRICTIONS – BAYLIS ROAD AND KENNINGTON
ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate the removal and replacement of analogue telecoms kiosks, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily close lengths of Cycle Lanes in:-

(a) Baylis Road, the east side between Waterloo Millennium Green and the common boundary of Nos.33 and 35 Baylis Road.

(b) Kennington Road, the west side, between the junctions with Cosser Street and Hercules Road.

2. Alternative routes for cyclists will be available on the main carriageway for each road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order comes into force on 27th September 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place between 27th September 2023 and 30th September 2023 and 17th October 2023 and 20th October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
