

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – HOLMDENE AVENUE & HERNE HILL**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the London Borough of Southwark, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that section of Holmdene Road which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of Herne Hill and a point 20 metres south-east of that kerb-line; and
- (b) suspend a section of the bus lane on the north-western side of Herne Hill, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Hollingbourne Road and the south-western kerb-line of Rollscourt Avenue.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Herne Hill, Hollingbourne Road, Warmington Road, Howletts Road and Half Moon Lane, and vice versa.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 14th September 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 14th September 2023 and the 19th September 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
