

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING
RESTRICTIONS – LOWER MARSH**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate the operation of a crane, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Lower Marsh which lies between the junction of Westminster Bridge Road and the common boundary of Nos. 136 and 138 Lower Marsh.
2. One way one way working on Lower Marsh between Frazier Street and Westminster Bridge Road is suspended to allow two-way working to maintain access to properties;
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Westminster Bridge Road, Baylis Road and Lower Marsh; and (b) Lower Marsh, Frazier Street, Baylis Road and Westminster Bridge Road.
4. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order will come into force on 1st October 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place on 1st October 2023 and 8th October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
